



## PRIVACY

FOREST EUROPE Liaison Unit Madrid is the technical department of FOREST EUROPE (Ministerial Conference on the Protection of Forests in Europe). This Conference is a high-level political initiative geared to cooperation in forestry issues in the Pan-European region. FOREST EUROPE promotes sustainable forestry management and focuses on the opportunities and problems in relation to forests and forestry science. The entity was created in 1990 and represents a political platform for dialogue on forestry issues in the Pan-European region.

46 European countries and the European Union are represented at FOREST EUROPE. Other non-European countries and international organisations participate as observers in the process. As such, FOREST EUROPE constitutes not only a forum for the cooperation of the ministers responsible for the forests, but also to ensure non-governmental and inter-governmental organisations contribute to the process with their knowledge and ideas.

### **Information collected**

We collect and process the following information you have chosen to provide us with:

- The information you provide on completing the registration form on our website. This includes the information provided on registering for the competition.
- The information you provide (name and e-mail address, for example) to ensure you receive all the updates we send you.
- If you contact us we may keep a record of your correspondence.
- Details of visits to our website including, but not limited to, traffic, the time of the visit, the location, and other access data.
- The IP address – when you visit our website we automatically collect your IP address, a unique identifier of the computer or other devices you use for access. This statistical information does not identify you personally.

On providing us with any type of personal information you fully understand and agree to the transfer of such personal information, in addition to the collection and processing of the same to other countries and territories. Any transfer or processing on our part shall be in compliance with this privacy policy and cookies.

#### **What are cookies?**

Functional Cookies	Registration cookies are generated when the User has logged in or commenced a session, and are used to identify the User in the Services for the following purposes:	To keep the User identified, so that after a Service is closed the browser or computer will access the said Service again at a later time or the next day, enabling the User to browse without having to log in again. This feature can be removed if the User clicks on the "end session" tab, whereby this Cookie is deleted and the User will have to log in again to identify himself on using the Service the next time.
